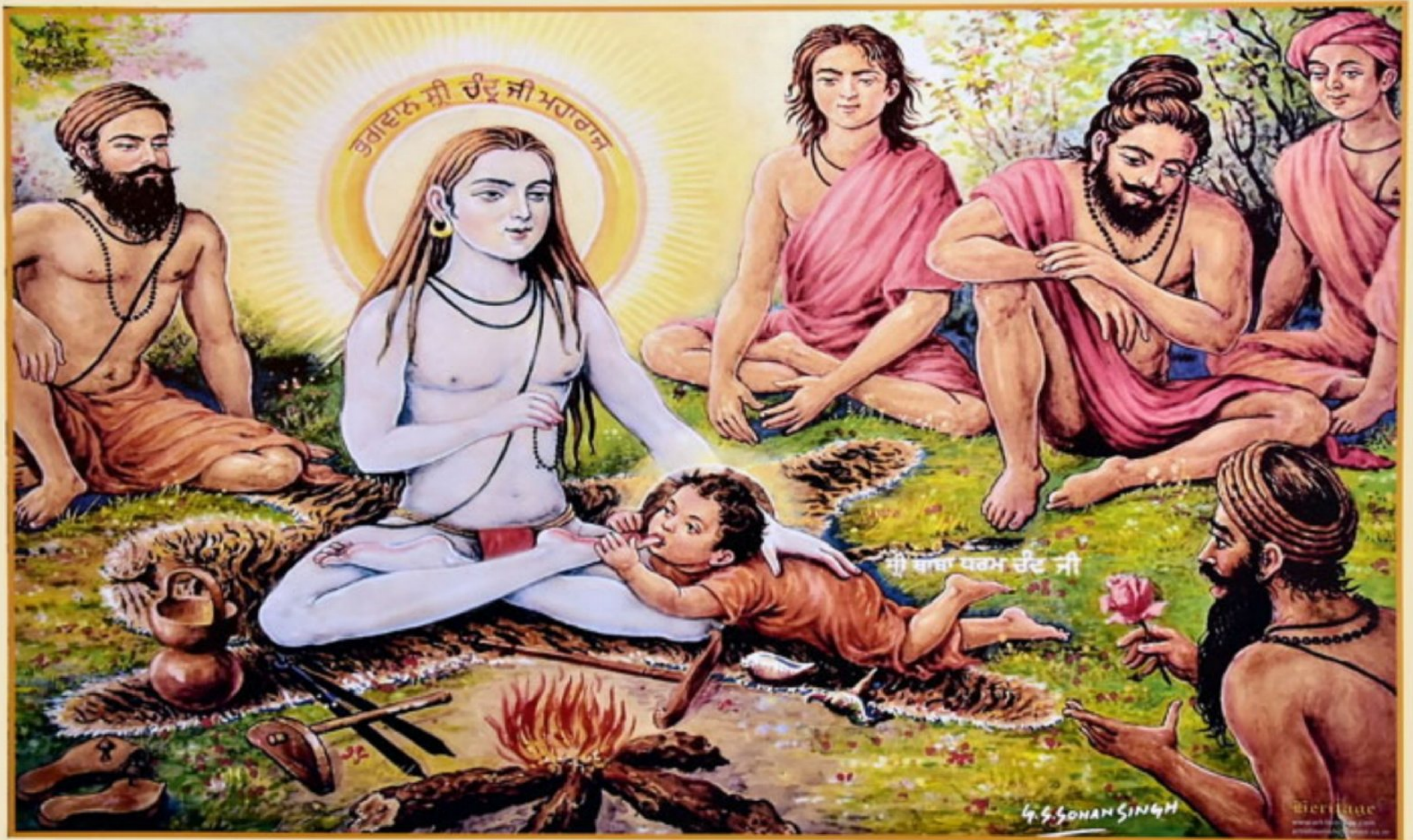

Meeting of Lord Shri Chandra Ji Maharaj with the King of Kabul (Afghanistan)



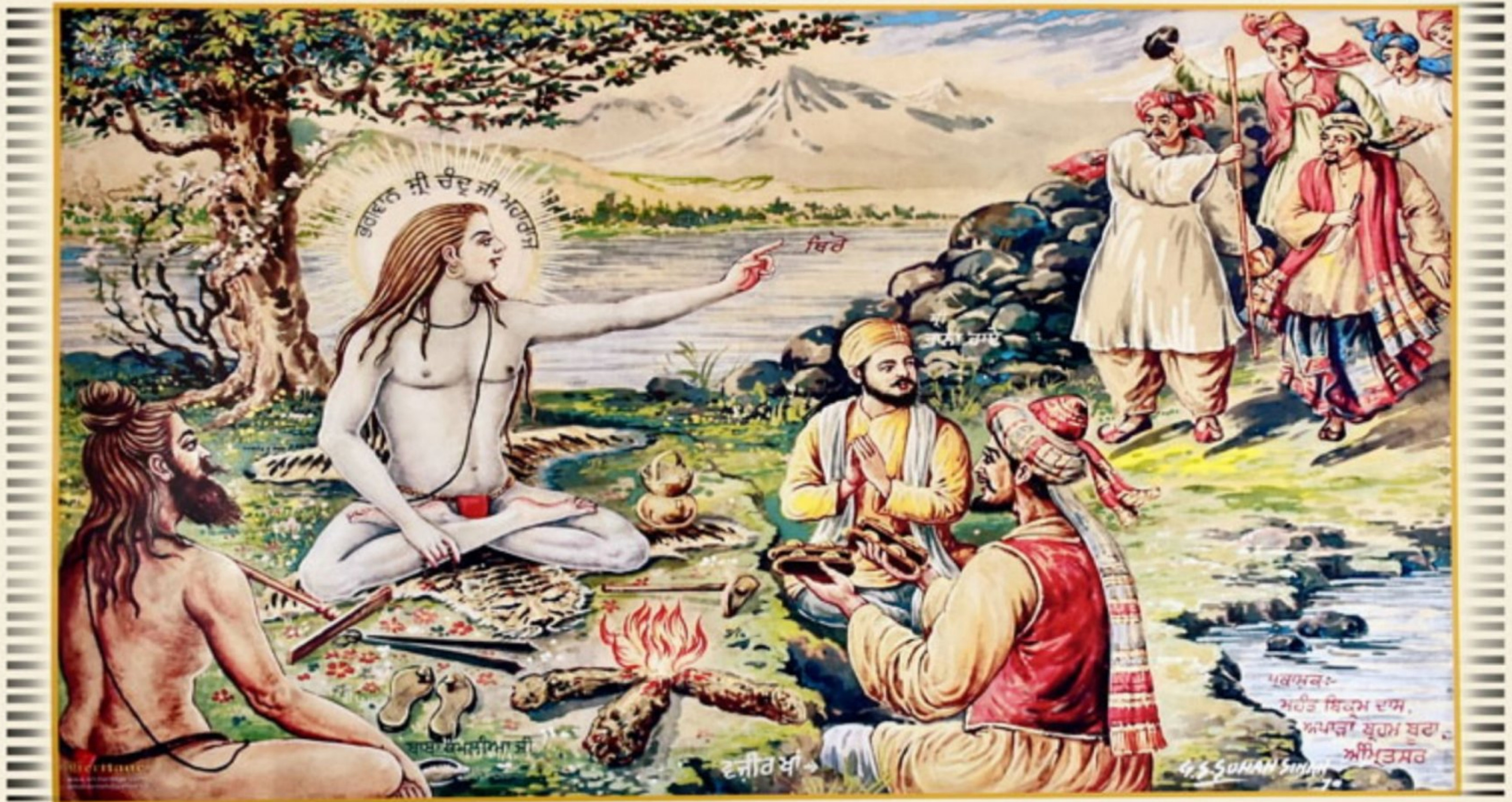
*When Humayun who had lost courage after losing the throne of Delhi. Sought refuge
Lord Shri Chandra Ji blessed him to get back his lost Kingdom.*



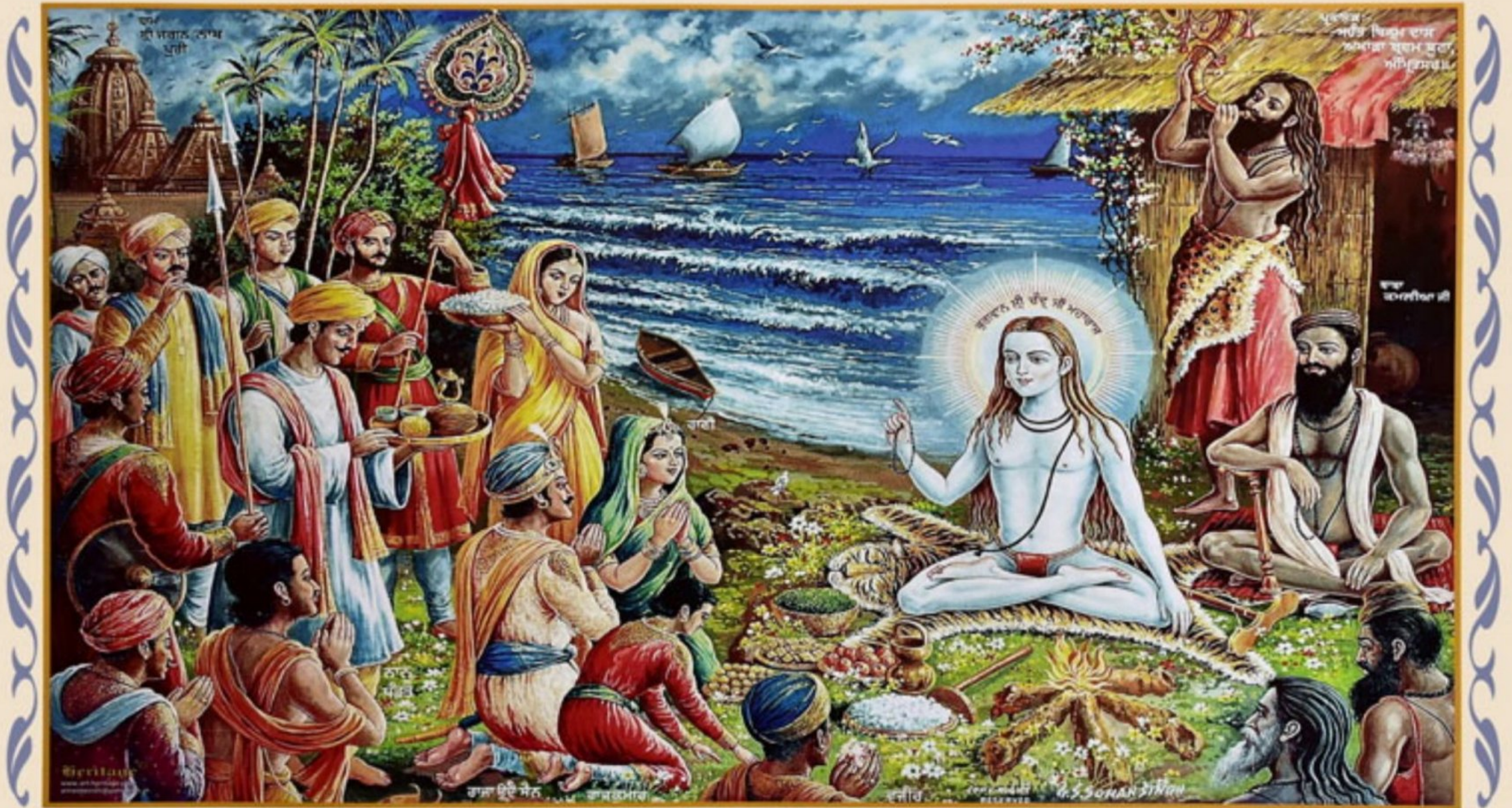
Lord Shri Chandra Ji brings back to life to dead child of an old Brahmin woman.
